
Wanlock Visions - Visions of the Past, Heritage Trail



Welcome to the 'Visions of the Past, Heritage Trail'

- The complete trail is approximately a two and a half-mile circular walk with several degrees of difficulty, as indicated by the colour-coded routes.
- The blue and red routes are the complete walks, over uneven terrain, with the red route being a more challenging trail to the Bay Mine.
- The yellow route is a much shorter walk over a firmer, yet still uneven terrain until the tarmac section of the route.
- The trail takes you passed various remnant buildings and areas linked to the Lead Mining Industry.
- Interpretation boards placed along the route will explain some of the histories of these local remnants as with Wanlockhead Village itself, and all within breathtaking scenery.

When walking please keep to the designated paths and bridleways - Be aware the weather changes very quickly in this area - Please be prepared and have suitable clothing and footwear.
